In June bee experts and enthusiasts will gather to discuss and see the latest discoveries and technologies from across member country regions at the Asian Apilculture Association Conference in June 2024.

Founded in 1993 and based in Beijing, China, the Asian Apicultural Association (AAA) is led by Professor Siriwat Wongsiri. With over 20 member countries, AAA facilitates communication among bee scientists and bee keepers in Asia. Since 1993, AAA has organised conferences for global collaboration in honey bee sciences, aiming to enhance research, improve beekeeping practices, and raise awareness about the vital role of bees in pollination and ecosystem preservation.

In 2024 their conference will be hosted in Fremantle, Western Australia supported by the Bee Industry Council of Western Australia.

The three days of Conference engagement a will provide a platform for scientists from around the globe to share their latest research findings on bee biology through oral presentations and poster sessions.

The conference will also serve as serve as a forum for beekeeping industry professionals to share their experiences, views, and ideas on the most recent advancements in beekeeping. The goal of the AAA is to promote the exchange of scientific and general information related to bee sciences and apiculture in Asia and to encourage international cooperation in analytical research of common problems with a common interest.

The Venue

The Esplanade Hotel, Fremantle is located at the mouth of the Swan River, just 25 minutes away from Perth, the capital of Western Australia.

The city's impressive heritage buildings are mostly constructed using the pale-coloured local limestone, which adds to their charm. The conference venue, the Esplanade Hotel, is located in the heart of the city.

There are a variety of lodging options available in the city, ranging from backpackers to 5-star luxury. A train line connects the Perth Airport to Fremantle, and once there, visitors can explore many attractions within walking distance of the venue.
